

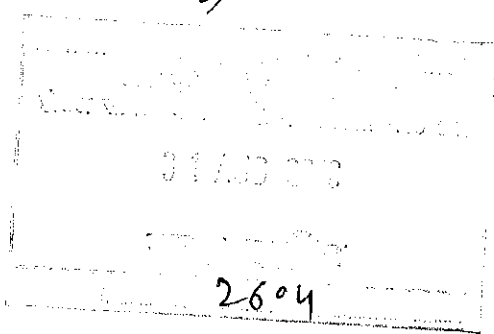


**Sub: Compliance report in respect of Board's Office Orders regarding transfer/postings in the grades of AC/DC of Customs, GST and Central Excise - reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Board's Office Orders No. 107/2018 and 108/2018 dated 03.07.2018 regarding transfer/ postings in the grade of Assistant / Deputy Commissioner of Customs, GST and Central Excise and to say that it has been brought to the notice of the Board that a large number of officers are yet to be relieved by the concerned Commissionerates/ Directorates for joining at their new place of postings, even though the prescribed time has expired long back.

2. It has now been decided by the Board that all such officers, who have not been relieved by the Commissionerates/ Directorates so far shall be relieved immediately and latest by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2018 failing which they shall be treated as "stand relieved" with effect from 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2018, unless prior approval/orders for their retention has been obtained from the Board or transfer has already been stayed by any Bench of CAT or any other court of law.
3. A compliance report in this regard may be sent to the Board by **05.09.2018**.
