4. In addition, you are directed to ensure that the following activities as detailed below should be undertaken during the Vigilance Awareness Week in your jurisdiction on the theme viz. “**My Vision-Corruption Free India**” (“मेरा लक्ष्य – भ्रष्टाचार मुक्त भारत”):-
