

**Subject:- Instruction dated 22/08/2019 issued by CBIC regarding enhancement of monetary limits for filing departmental appeals in legacy matters in CESTAT, High Courts and Supreme Court**

Please refer to the instruction of even number dated 22.08.2019 prescribing the revised monetary limits for filing departmental appeals in Supreme Court, High Courts & CESTAT for legacy cases of Central Excise and Service Tax. It has also been directed to withdraw the appeals pending in Supreme Court, High Courts & CESTAT in accordance with the said instruction.

The Board has decided that all cases covered by the said instruction be identified by 5/9/2019 and applications for withdrawal should invariably be filed by 15.09.2019 and all of them withdrawn by 15.10.2019. 
